NOTICE OF PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING

N. Grand Avenue/South Street Reconstruction Project

All interested persons are hereby notified that the City of Waukesha will hold an open-house style information meeting to discuss the reconstruction of N. Grand Avenue and South Street.

The meeting will be held on **Monday, February 20th at City of Waukesha City Hall Council Chambers, 201 Delafield Street, Waukesha, WI, from 5:00 to 6:00 p.m. You must enter through the lower level glass doors.** You may attend anytime during these hours. A short presentation will be held at 5:15 p.m.

As approved in the 2017 CIP budget, it is planned to reconstruct N. Grand Avenue from Wisconsin Avenue to W. Main St. and South Street from Clinton St. to N. Grand Avenue in 2017. The meeting is to present the improvements, traffic control and schedule, and to receive input on the project. Persons with a concern for or knowledge of drainage problems, basements that extend under the sidewalk or environmental issues such as underground storage tanks are encouraged to attend this meeting and provide information to the Engineer. Exhibits will be on display showing the proposed layout and plans. The Contractor will also be in attendance.

The project will include installation of new water main, relay and lining of the sanitary sewer main and laterals, storm sewer rehabilitation, pedestrian ramp reconstruction, sidewalk replacement and installation of a wider stone paver terrace. Some existing trees within the terrace will be removed as a part of the project and new street trees will be planted.

Project construction is scheduled to begin in early March 2017. Construction for this project will close N. Grand Avenue and South Street to through traffic. Adjacent property owners will not be assessed for the improvement costs.

In order to expedite the overall reconstruction project schedule, and to accommodate the proposed infrastructure improvements included in this project, We Energies will need to relocate their gas main facility along N. Grand Avenue. The gas main relocation work is expected to start during the week of February 13th, and require sections of N. Grand Avenue to be closed to through traffic in phases.
