You must have your branches out by 7am on the day of your pick up.

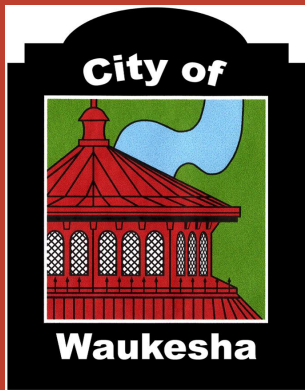
