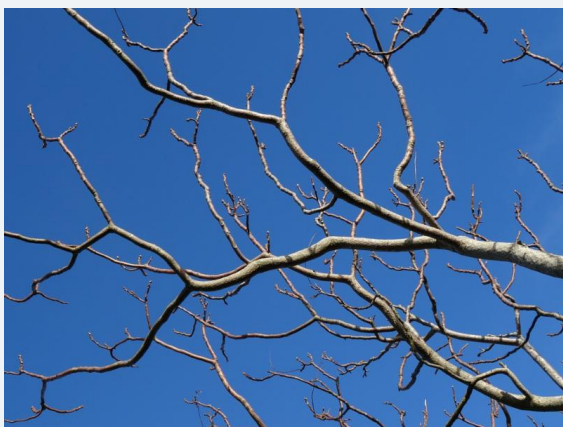


Work Has Begun

Drug Drop Box

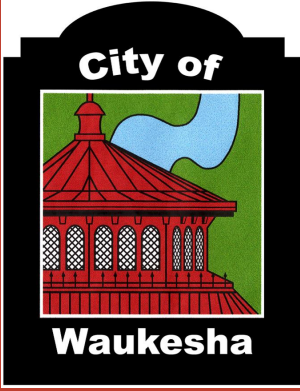
