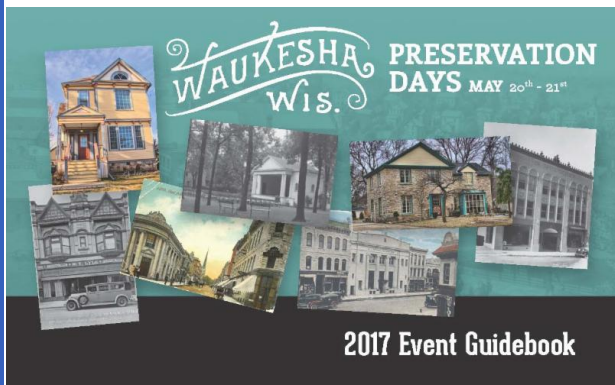

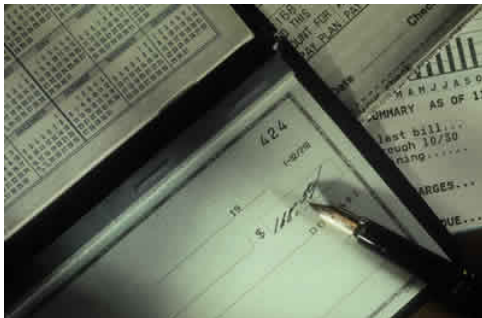


## National Police Week

If you talked with the Assessor's Office during "Open Book" and are still not satisfied with your property assessment, the Board of Review is the next level of appeal. The first meeting of the Board of Review is scheduled for May 22 at 8am.

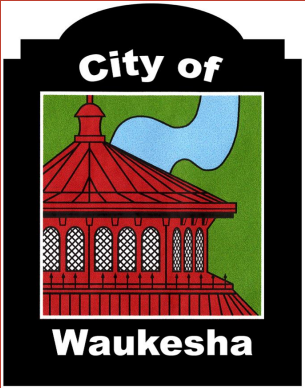
To appear before the Board, you must file a "Notice of Intent" with the City Clerk at least 48 hours prior to the first meeting of the Board. You must also



file a written "ObjectionForm" with the City Clerk prior to or within the first two hours of the firstBoard meeting. An appointment is necessary to meet with the Board ofReview.
