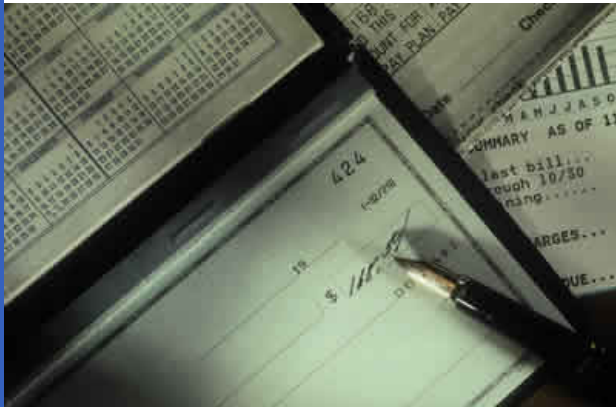


National Public Works Week

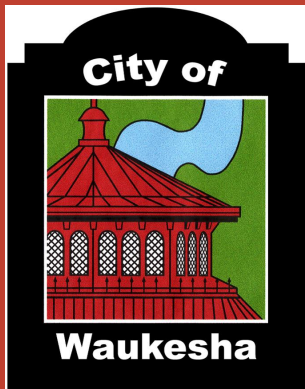


Final Installment Due
