Did you know? Each home is allowed to put beside their trash can up to 3 bulky items per week (6 items per month).

Examples of a bulky item include, mattresses, chairs, sofas, and other items. There is no bulky recycling pick-up and loose trash bags will not be



collected if they are outside of your can.

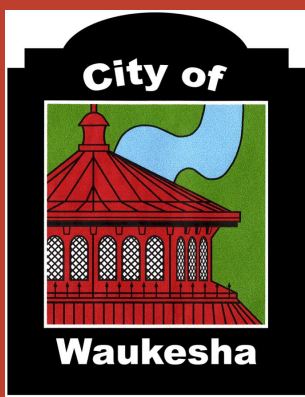
New Website
