The 4th of July is almost here! We hope to see you at the Waukesha festivities.

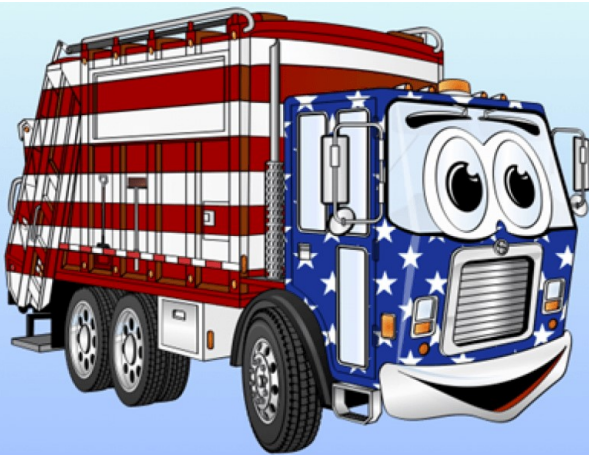
Tuesday, July 4:

Monday, July 3- Regular Collections

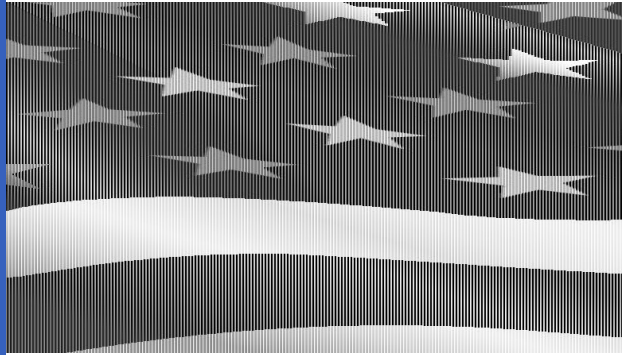
Tuesday, July 4- No collections

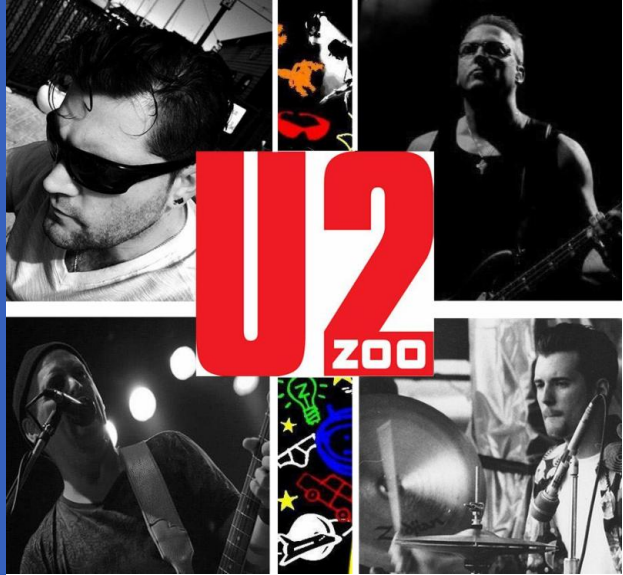

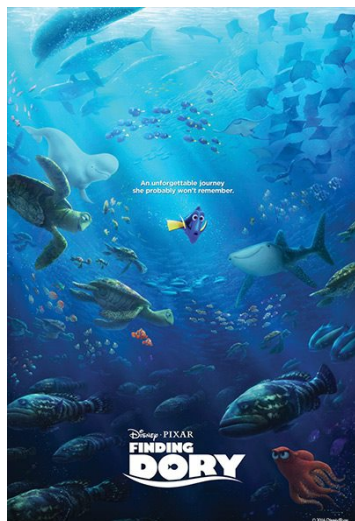


Construction Updates

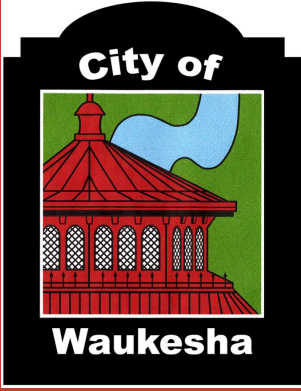


Monday Night at the Movies
