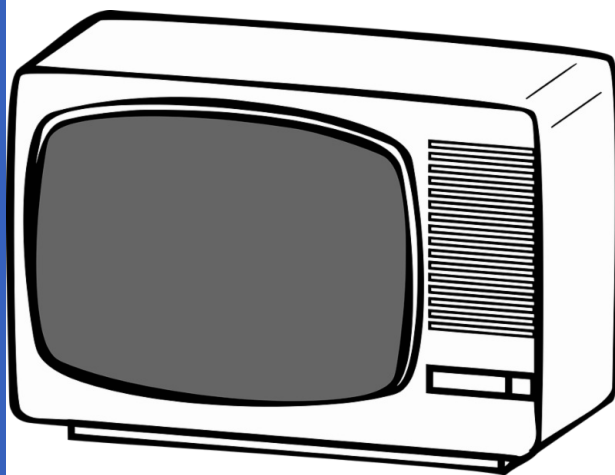


## Testing Fire Hydrants

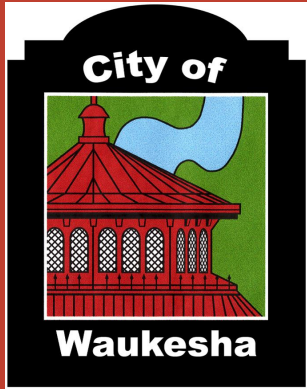


### **Pet Memorial Garden**
