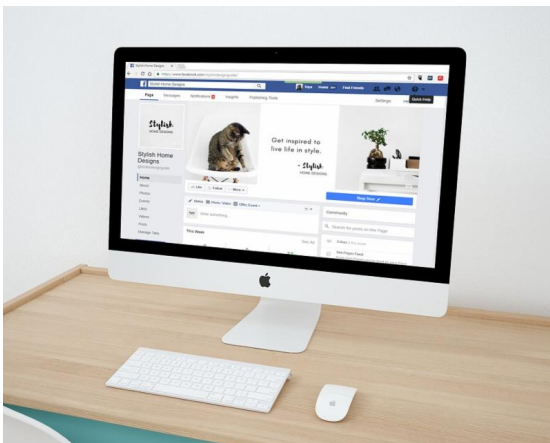

Tribute Tuesday Coming

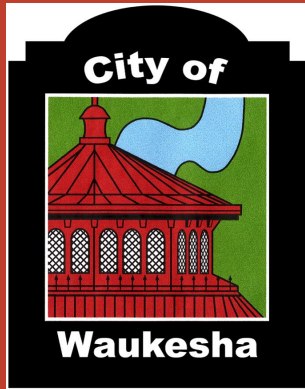
On September 12, get to the last Tribute Tuesday concert of the season... a Kenny Chesney tribute!
