Take a tour of the Fire Station, view the fire trucks, and meet some of the firefighters!



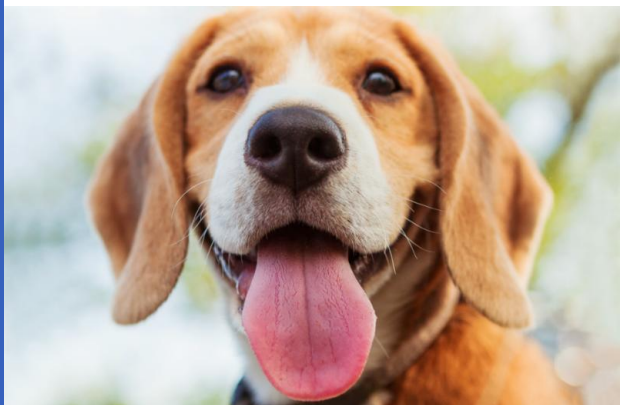
## Howl-O-Ween

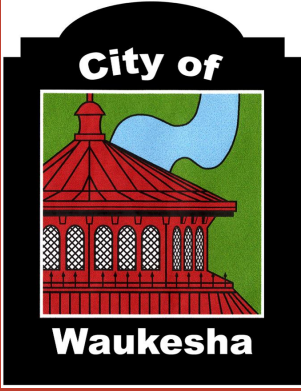
## Puppy Prance Pet Walk
