We are currently completing a housing study to better understand existing and future needs for housing in the City.

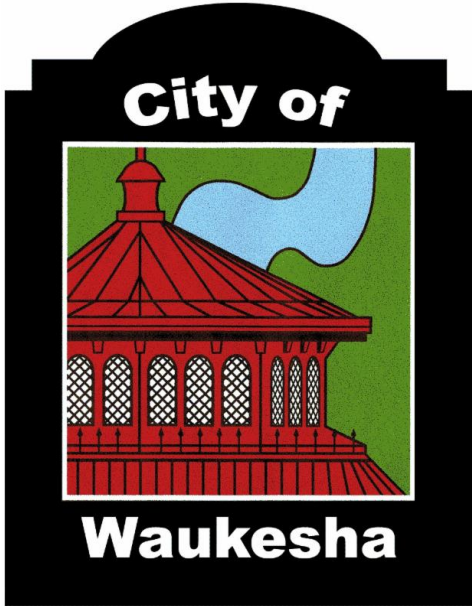

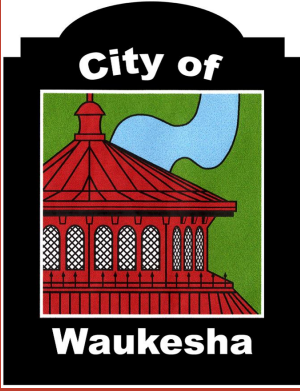
