2018 Drop-Off Center Fees

Some changes will be coming to the Drop-Off Center in 2018.

Changes include:

- 1) The season pass will become a “yard material pass” only, no longer covering bulky trash disposal. Instead, all loads of bulky trash disposal will have to be paid for per load.
- 2) Senior residents (aged 62 and older) will begin paying a rate for bulky trash disposal. The rate is still discounted. Yard material and recycling are still accepted at no charge from senior residents.
- 3) For latex paint disposal, all residents will pay 25 cents per gallon for drop off.

4) New for 2018, there will be a Day Pass option for yard material or bulky trash disposal.

Traffic Incident Response Week

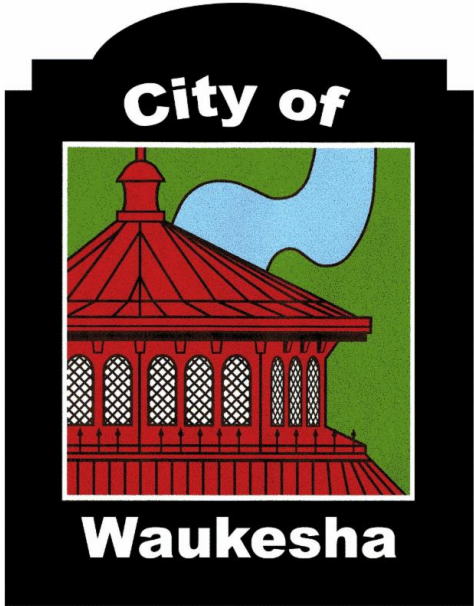

Leaf Schedule

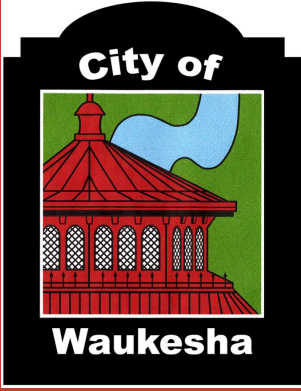
Leaf pickup schedule for the remainder of this week:
