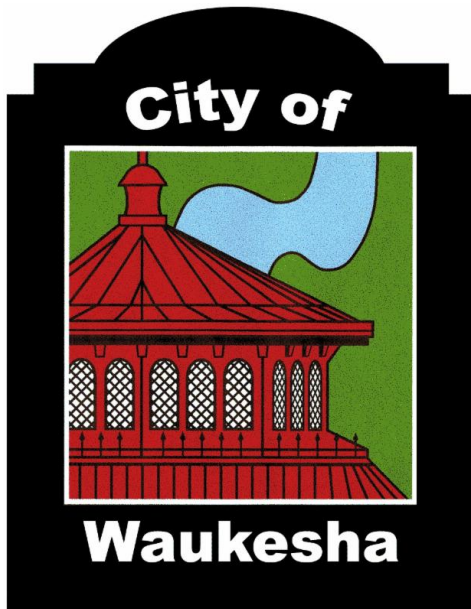
Water Open Houses

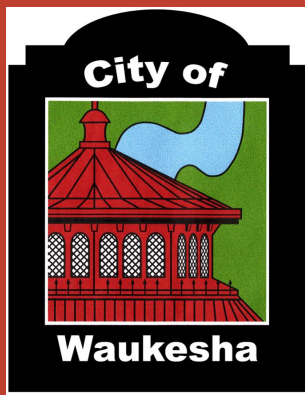
