In-Person Absentee Voting Starts Monday

The Spring Primary election will be held on Tuesday, February 20th. Polling locations will be open from 7am-8pm on that day.

You can also vote in-person absentee at City Hall (201 Delafield St) during the following times:

- Monday, Feb. 5 through Friday, Feb. 9 from 8am-4:30pm
- Monday Feb. 12 through Thursday, Feb 15 from 8am-4:30pm
- Friday, February 16 from 8am-5pm

Safety Reminder

Waukesha Water Utility employees will ALWAYS have proper identification and be in a vehicle that is clearly marked Waukesha Water Utility. On a rare occasion, they may need to notify you of a water situation (water main break) and come to your front door unannounced. However, they would never ask to enter your home without an appointment.

For your safety, if someone comes to

your door and claims to be an employee of the Waukesha Water Utility:

- You do NOT have to open your door
- Check their uniform. Waukesha Water Utility workers wear fluorescent vests or blue uniforms with their name and Water Utility logo on the front.
- Ask them to show their identification.
- You can call the Water Utility at 262-521-5272 to verify the person.

If you are suspicious of anyone coming to your home asking for access, call the Police.

Frame Park Baseball and Whiterock Redevelopment Area

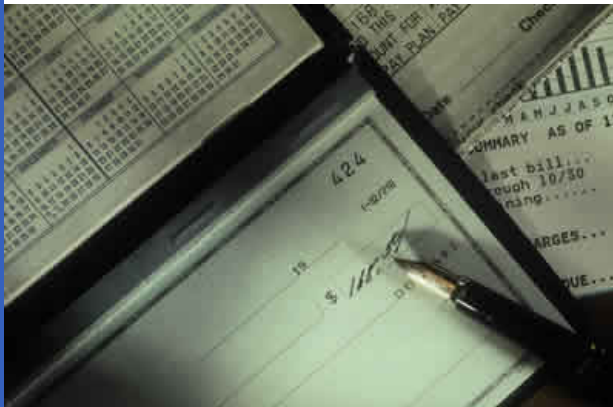
There are a number of upcoming meetings where the Baseball Field Enhancement and Whiterock Redevelopment will be discussed. The list of meetings is below. Please note,

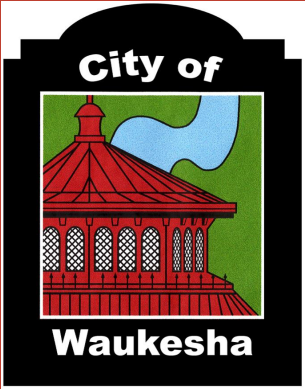
