NEW Fire Station #3

The new Fire Station #3 (2440 Les Paul Parkway) is expected to be operational on Monday! The old Fire Station #3 (1210 Sentry Drive) will no longer be in use. The new station is strategically located to best serve the residents of Waukesha.

Please note, there is a warning system installed that will flash on Les Paul Parkway to alert drivers when emergency vehicles will be entering traffic.

This new station will also house a Police sub-station. The Police will be operational from the station in March.

A public ribbon cutting and open house are being planned for early April.



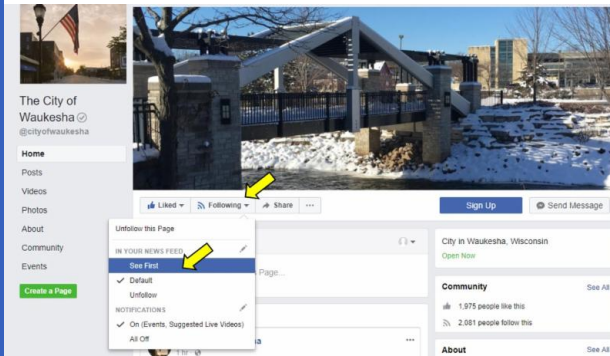
Thank you Engineers

In 2015, the Police Department implemented a drug disposal program that encourages residents to drop off their unused and unwanted prescription drugs and medications. The goal of this program is to provide a safe, secure and anonymous location to dispose of medications. This ensures that medications do not end up in the wrong hands and do not end up in the water supply.

Thanks to your help, in 2017, the Waukesha Police Department collected **1,283 pounds** of prescription drugs and medications! Since the program started in 2015, the Department has collected **2,047 pounds**.

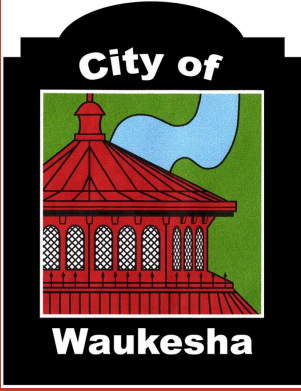
Dog and Cat Licenses
