The City is currently negotiating a draft contract with Big Top Waukesha to build a stadium at Mindiola Park that would support baseball and soccer.

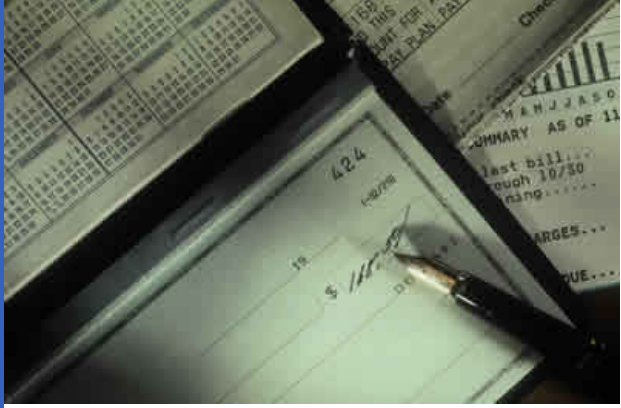
The proposal was discussed and supported at the Parks, Recreation and Forestry Board this past Monday, March 19. You can [view the presentation slides here](#).

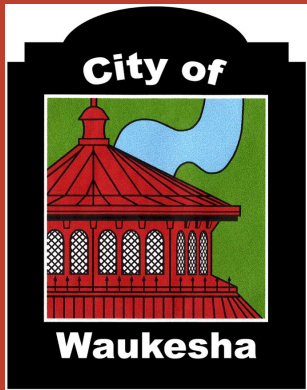
Landmark Commission Awards
