## Trailbreaker Run

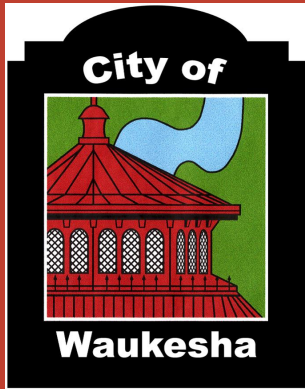
The Trailbreaker run is coming up this Saturday, April 7th. It's not too late to register for the 5k, 10k, half marathon or
