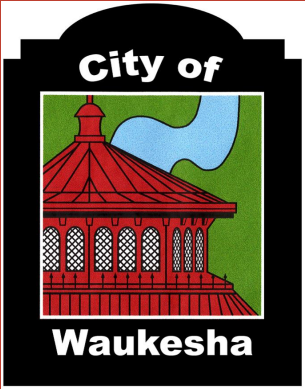


Seconds Matter
