Summer Bonfires

In residential areas, open fires are permitted between the hours of 3pm - 12am provided that the following requirements are met:

- Not conducted less than 25 feet from any structure, tree, shrub, bush, fence or combustible material
- Must be conducted in a below-ground fire pit or in an Outdoor Fireplace
- Not permitted when the wind speeds exceed 10 miles per hour
- Materials shall not include rubbish, recyclables, yard waste, green wood, treated lumber, any material with rubber, plastic, leather or petroleum based materials and shall not contain any flammable or combustible

liquids

- Adequate fire suppression equipment shall be present on the property
- Flame should not exceed 3 feet from the base of the fire
- Must be attended by a person at least 18 years of age at all times

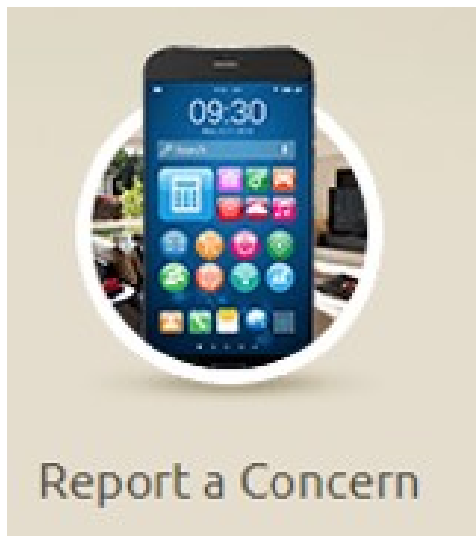
Monday Night at the Movies

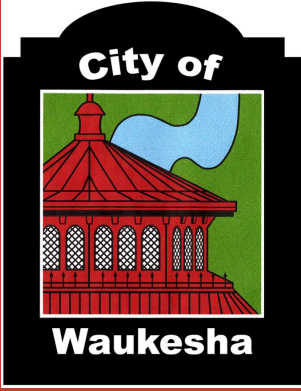
