The Waukesha 4th of July festivities take place tomorrow!

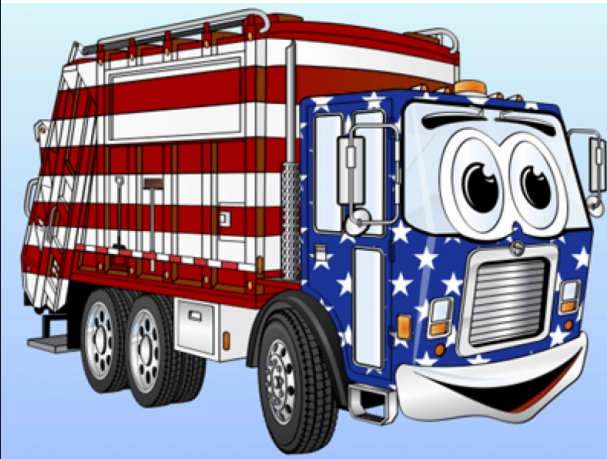
#### Wednesday, July 4:

## Remember These Tips

When using your grill over the holiday, keep these safety tips in mind:

- Keep your grill at least 3 feet from any siding, deck rails and eaves.
- Clean your grill after each use. This will remove grease that can start a fire.
- Open your gas grill before lighting.
- Grills that use charcoal or gas cannot be used on balconies of buildings that contain 3 or more units.
- Grills should not be used when the wind is excessive.

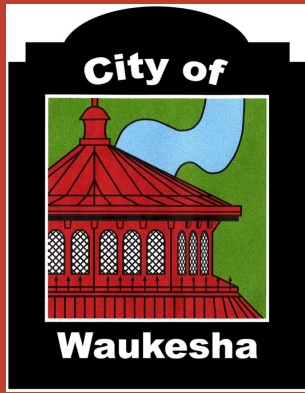
