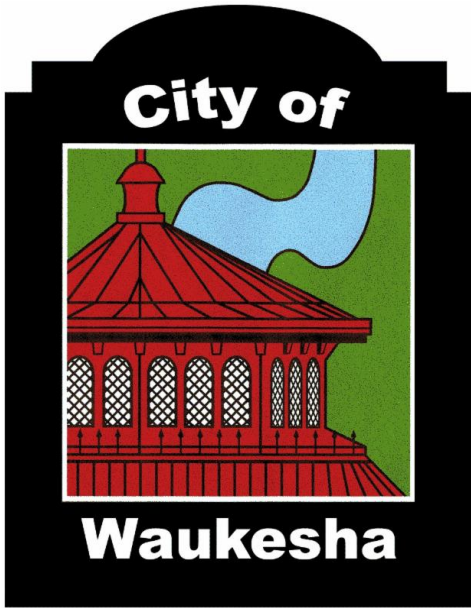

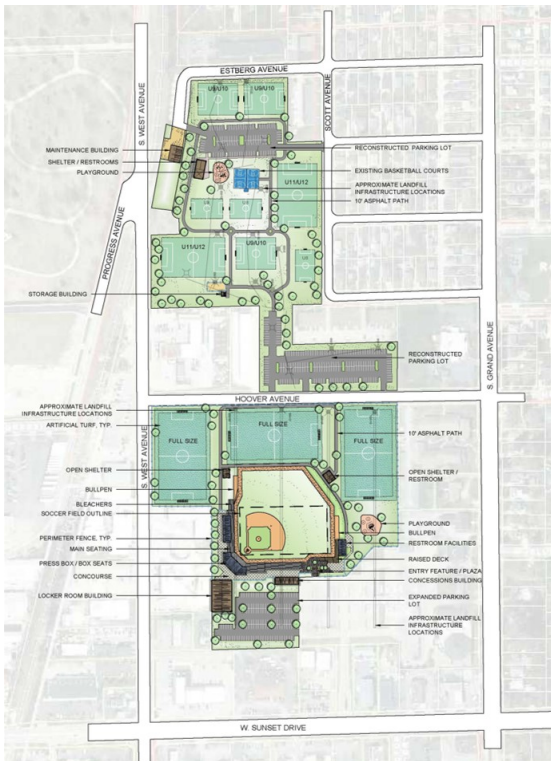
Aldermanic Position Open

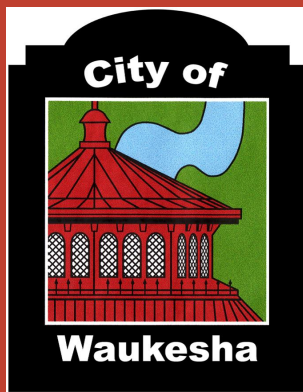
