Tues, Jan. 1: NO COLLECTIONS

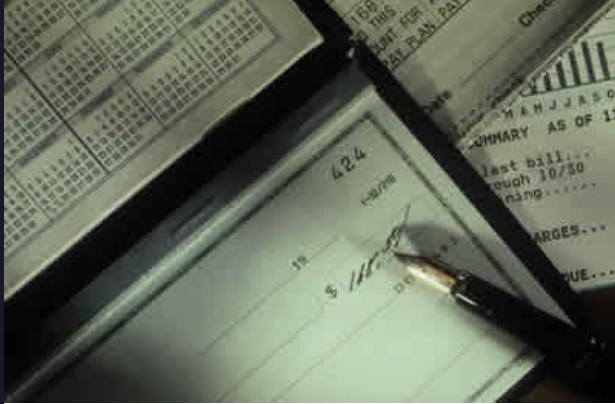
Wed, Jan. 2: Regular Tuesday Recycling/Garbage

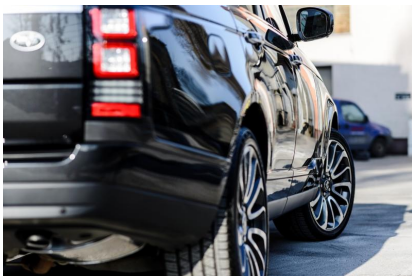


Plan Ahead

Aside from those closures, City Hall is open Monday-Friday from 8am-4:30pm.

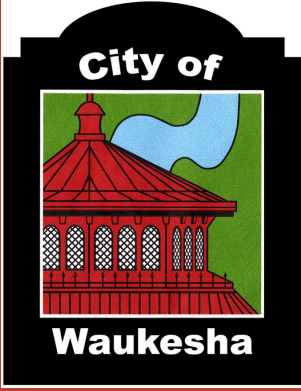


Overnight Parking
