Garbage/Recycling– Remainder of this week



This week Advanced Disposal is making up for recycling collections that were cancelled last week. To accomplish this extra collection there are some schedule changes. In addition, the crews are working later than normal hours to get to everyone.

Wednesday, February 6: They will continue collections from Tuesday. This includes all Tuesday and Wednesday Garbage/ Tuesday and Wednesday recycling. If your items were not collected yesterday, they should be collected today or tomorrow (Thursday).

Thursday, February 7: Thursday Garbage / Thursday Route A recycling – normal schedule

Friday, February 8: Friday Garbage/ Friday Route A recycling-normal schedule

Advanced Disposal will accept garbage bags placed outside the can this week to make-up for any garbage collection that was missed last week.

Next week, starting February 11, services return to the regular schedule.

Household Hazardous Waste Collection



The next drop off day for Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) in Waukesha will be THIS Saturday, February 9 from 8am-noon at 900 Sentry Drive (old incinerator).

Waste is generally considered hazardous if it is:

- ignitable (burns readily)
- corrosive
- reactive (explosive)
- contains certain toxic chemicals

It is important that Hazardous Waste is properly disposed of and does not go into your regular garbage.

Drop off days will take place in the City on the 2nd Saturday of the month for February - March and on the 2nd and 4th Saturdays of the month in April - October.

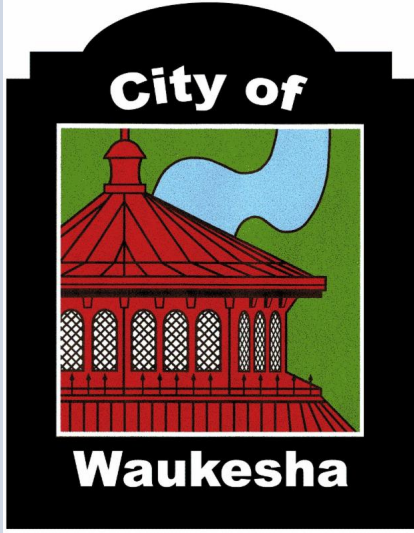
