## Firing up the Grill



Many of you will be firing up the grill for the first time this season. Let's stay safe and remember the following:

- Keep your grill at least 3 feet from any siding, deck rails and eaves.
- Clean your grill after each use. This will remove grease that can start a fire.
- Open your gas grill before lighting.
- Don't be tempted on a rainy day to use outdoor cooking equipment inside- not even in a garage, or on a porch or balcony. Never use a gas-fired barbecue inside any structure.

# Bike and Pedestrian Safety



With the warmer weather, many of us are anxious to get outside! Let's all share the road and have a safe and enjoyable summer!

## Cyclists

- Always wear a helmet
- Ride with traffic and adhere to all traffic rules (including stopping at stop signs)
- Utilize painted bike lanes where available
- Be visible
- Ride single file on roadways

## Pedestrians

- Walk on sidewalks where available.
- If no sidewalks, walk facing traffic and as far away from traffic as possible
- Keep alert at all times. Don't be distracted by electronic devices
- Cross roads at cross walks and intersections
- Be visible

## Motorists

- Keep your eyes on the road
- Yield to cyclists as you would any other vehicle
- Yield to pedestrians at cross walks and intersections
- Don't drive over the speed limit
- Stay alert! Don't be distracted by electronic devices

## Tribute Tuesday- Beach Boys



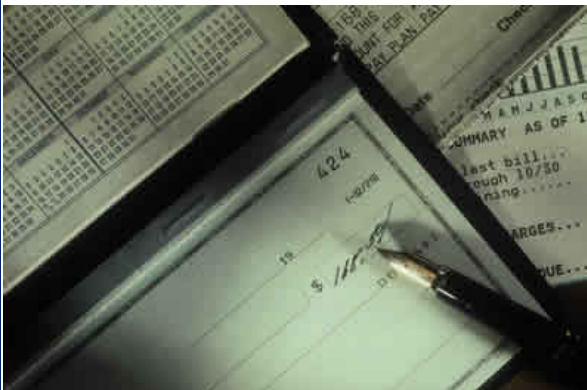
Only three weeks away from our first Tribute Tuesday in the Park ....Beach Boys Tribute!

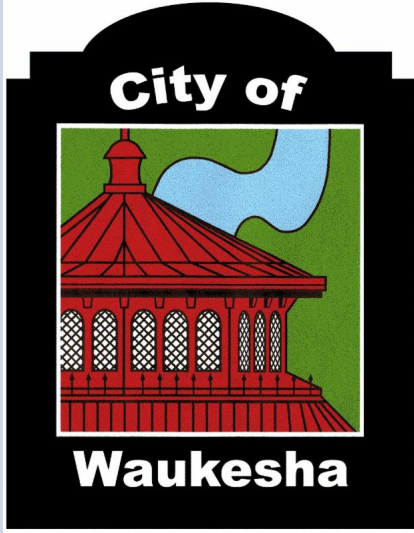
