## Bids Received for Proposed New City Hall

On Friday, August 16 bids were received for the proposed City Hall project. There were four bidders on the project with Greenfire Management Service as the low bidder with a bid of \$19,405,000. This bid was under the City's budgeted estimate for the project.

The project bids will go to the Board of Public Works for consideration on August 22, 2019 and then to the Common Council at their meeting on September 3, 2019.

If approved, the groundbreaking for the new City Hall could occur as early as the end of September with an estimated

project completion date of January 2021. The current City Hall building would remain open to serve the public during the construction.

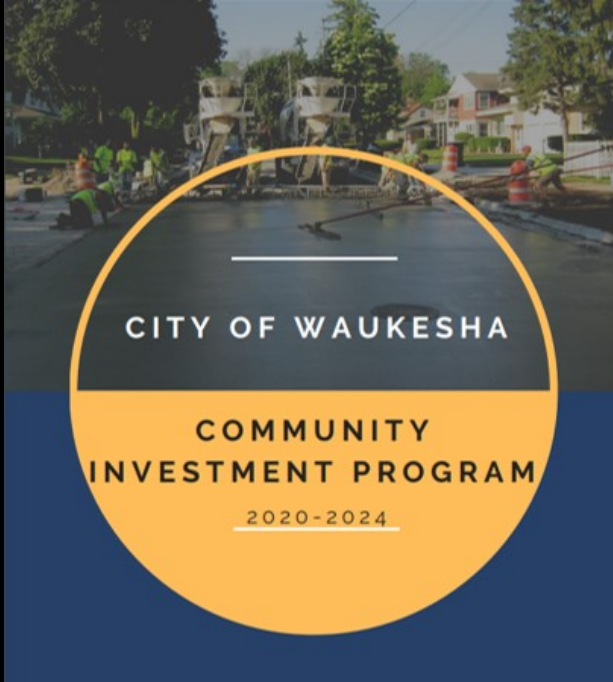

The proposed Community Investment

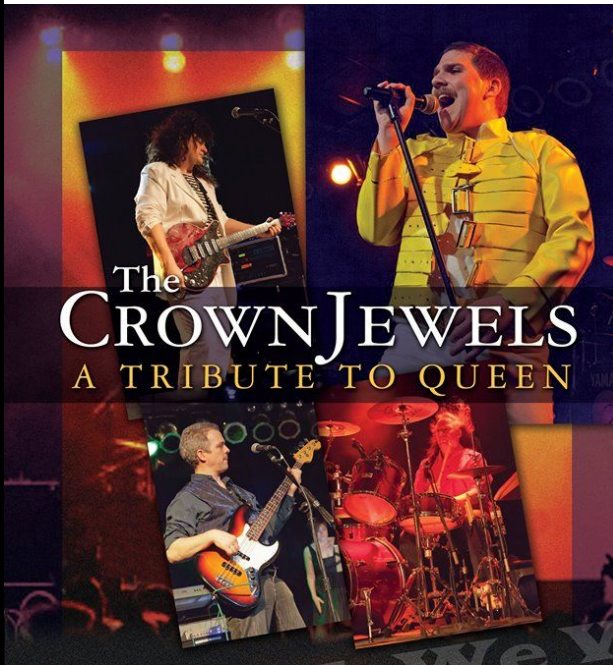


Program (CIP) for 2020-2024 has been released and is being reviewed by the Finance Committee. It is scheduled to go before the Common Council on September 17. The CIP is a planning tool based on long-range physical planning and financial projections that forecast the City of Waukesha's capital needs over a five year period.

The proposed operating budget is scheduled to be released on September 24. It will start with review by the Finance Committee. Final review on the budget by the Common Council is scheduled for November 5.

Residents are encouraged come to the public budget open house on October 2 from 5-7pm at Mountain Top Coffee.
