Fall Leaf Collection

The City will start collecting leaves on October 21 and continue into early December.

- Leaves need to be out by 7am on the day of collection
- Leaves should be out loose (not in bags, on tarps or in containers)
- Do not put your leaves near fixed items such as trees, mailboxes, or hydrants
