Help honor our Veterans by coming to this year's Operation Honor this Saturday,

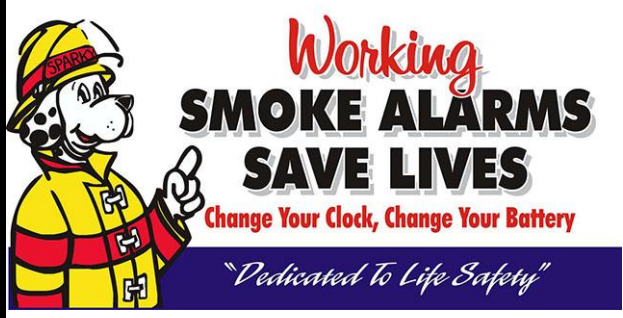


November 2nd.

Correction: Last week it stated that Police Chief Jack would be retiring in January 2021. He is retiring in January 2020.

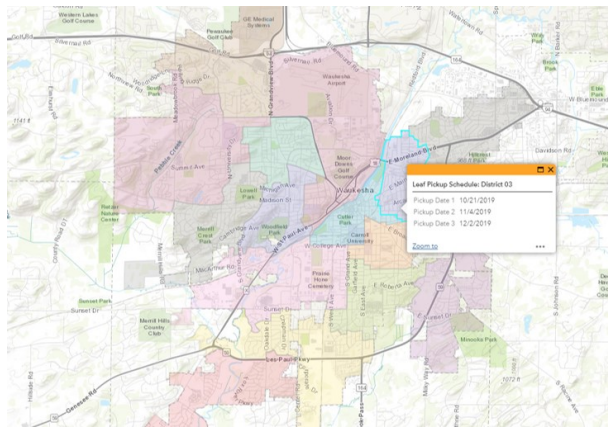


The City, in coordination with the Police & Fire Commission, has hired a search firm and is currently undertaking a national search for a new Police Chief.
