Household Hazardous Waste Drop-Off

The next drop off day for Household Hazardous Waste in Waukesha will be on Saturday, February 8 from 8am-noon at 900 Sentry Drive (old incinerator).

Waste is generally considered hazardous if it is:

- ignitable (burns readily)
- corrosive
- reactive (explosive)
- contains certain toxic chemicals
