### **“Safer at Home” Orders Lifted**

With the Supreme Court decision on May 13<sup>th</sup>, the “Safer at Home” orders have been lifted. There are currently no additional orders in place in the City of Waukesha for businesses and organizations.

The health and safety of all residents in our community remains a top priority. The COVID-19 virus is still present in our community. We continue to ask that everyone take personal responsibility for stopping the spread of the virus.

All businesses looking to re-open, are asked to follow the Wisconsin Economic Development Corporation reopening guidelines ( <https://wedc.org/reopen-guidelines/>). The guidelines provide industry specific safe business practices.

All residents are asked to continue to follow the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) guidelines for preventing the spread of the virus including:

- Wash your hands often
- Avoid close contact with those who are sick and with other people outside of your home
- Cover your mouth and nose with a cloth face cover when around others
- Cover coughs and sneezes
- Clean and disinfect regularly
