Free Concert and Pizza in the Park

WAUKESHA, WI - The City of Waukesha announces Pizza, Polka, Art in the Park, will take place on Tues., May 11 from 5:30 to 7:00 p.m. at the Amphitheater in Frame Park, 1150 Frame Park Dr. Waukesha. This celebration of early childhood education is a collaboration of community partners including the City of Waukesha and the School District of Waukesha and is a featured activity of the City of Waukesha's 125th Anniversary celebrations. The event will showcase what school was like 125 years ago, feature 4K artwork, offer free pizza (while supplies last), and include live polka music.

"We are looking forward bringing people together, celebrating early childhood in the Waukesha community, and learning about what school was like when our City first began," said Mayor Shawn Reilly.

"The support of our community around early childhood programming is worth celebrating," said Dr. James Sebert, Superintendent of Schools.

In celebration of the City's 125th Anniversary and the School District's rich history, participants will be challenged to think about schoolhouses and school supplies 125 years ago. Slates (mini blackboards) will be given away to participants, while supplies last. The event is also recognized as a national "Kids to Parks Day" event in which families are encouraged to discover and explore the great outdoors.

The School District of Waukesha 4K, "Future 4 Waukesha," program is both community and school based. Community partners such as area preschools, private schools and childcare programs provide District 4K classrooms. The program is designed to prepare children for success in Kindergarten and to begin the journey for parents in supporting their child's education. Parent involvement, 4K events and home visits are part of the program.

The City of Waukesha, WI is an award-winning community located along the shores of the Fox River, 15 miles west of Milwaukee. Waukesha is the seventh largest City in the state with a population of just over 72,000 people. Throughout 2021, the City is celebrating its 125th anniversary since incorporation with the theme of "Looking Back-Reaching Forward."
