



Route 906 Discontinued After June 30, 2020

As part of the 2020 Waukesha County Transit budget, funding for Route 906 was extended for 1 trip in each direction per weekday through June 30, 2020 to allow passengers time to develop alternative transportation plans. After June 30, 2020, the Route 906 will discontinue service. Below are some suggested alternatives to consider when service on Route 906 ceases.

1. Milwaukee County Transit System (MCTS) Route 43-Hales Corners Flyer
