A Resolution to indicate Plan Commission endorsement and support of the conversion of E. St. Paul Avenue and E. North Street to two-way traffic.

WHEREAS, the City of Waukesha adopted the Downtown/Central City Master Plan in 1998, which included a goal of converting downtown streets from one-way to two-way to make downtown Waukesha easier to navigate, reduce driver confusion, and improve the viability of downtown businesses; and


WHEREAS, the City of Waukesha adopted the Central City Master Plan in 2012, which had a goal to create an easy-to navigate sequence from Interstate 94 to Downtown Waukesha and to make it into a true gateway; and

WHEREAS, the 2012 Central City Master Plan also has a goal of conversion of St. Paul Avenue and North Street as two-way streets to create a crossover that allows St. Paul to become the main route that comes into Downtown; and

WHEREAS, the proposed 2020 Community Investment Program (CIP) has included conversion of the current one-way pair street system of St. Paul Avenue and North Street to a two-way street system for budget year 2022;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Plan Commission endorses and supports the conversion of the one-way pair street system of E. St Paul Avenue and E. North Street to a two-way street system as a project for budget year 2022.
