NOTICE OF PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING

St. Paul Avenue and North Street Corridor Improvements

All interested persons are hereby notified that the City of Waukesha will hold an open house style information meeting to discuss the St. Paul Avenue and North Street Corridor Improvements Project.

The meeting will be held on **Thursday, January 13th at the City of Waukesha City Hall Council Chambers, 201 Delafield Street, Waukesha, WI, from 4:00 to 6:00 p.m.** You may attend anytime during these hours. The City is creating a recorded presentation explaining the project and the corridor improvements for those who are unable to attend or looking for additional information. This will be posted on the City's YouTube page (<https://www.youtube.com/c/CityofWaukesha>) and the City's social media pages.

As funded in the 2022 CIP budget, it is planned to reconstruct St. Paul Avenue (from Mountain Ave to Madison Street), North Street (from St. Paul Ave to Madison), Madison St (from The Fox River to Ann Street), and to convert both North Street and St. Paul Avenue from Wisconsin Avenue to Albert Street to two-way operation. The meeting is to present the improvements, preliminary schedule, and to receive input on the project. Persons with a concern for or knowledge of drainage problems, basements that extend under the sidewalk or environmental issues such as underground storage tanks are encouraged to attend this meeting and provide information to the Engineers. Exhibits will be on display showing the proposed layout.

The project will include spot installation of new water main, lining and spot relay of the sanitary sewer main and laterals, storm sewer relay and rehabilitation, roadway reconstruction, traffic signal replacement & rehabilitation, bridge rehabilitation, pedestrian ramp reconstruction, and sidewalk replacement.

Construction is scheduled to begin in March 2022. Construction for this project will be phased to keep one travel lane open in each direction as much as possible, however, sections of both North Street and St. Paul Avenue will need to be closed to complete the work.

Representatives from the City of Waukesha Public Works Department will be available to address concerns and answer questions. Public input is encouraged.
