

# 2020 Brush/Branch Pickup Information



**WHEN: May 4<sup>th</sup> to May 8<sup>th</sup>, 2020**

- The brush/branch pickup will occur on the **same day** as your residential garbage pickup (note: the city will pick up the branches, not the garbage drivers.)
- Residents must have their brush/branches out by **7 a.m.** day of pickup.
- Residents may begin piling brush/branches at the curb on **April 20<sup>th</sup>**.



## **RULES:**

- Brush/branches must be set **on the terrace** (grass area between curb and sidewalk). Do NOT place material in the street and do NOT block the sidewalk.
- The brush/branches should be set with the **butt ends at the curb** (unless the length of the brush/branches blocks the sidewalk – then they need to be set the long way.)
- Branches/brush can be up to **3 inches in diameter and 6 feet long**.
- Do **NOT** include very small twigs, other yard waste, or leaves. They will not be collected.
- Do **NOT** tie the brush/branches into bundles. Do **NOT** put into bags, boxes or other containers. Keep brush/branches loose in piles set on the ground.
- Do **NOT include any other objects** in the brush/branch pile. Pure brush/branches only!

## **DROP-OFF CENTER:**

Residents may also bring their brush/branches to the City Drop-Off Center (750 Sentry Dr.) for FREE during open public hours that week (**Wednesday, May 6<sup>th</sup> and Saturday, May 9<sup>th</sup>**).
