Please have the leaves raked out to **the terrace area** (the grassy area between the sidewalk and the street) in front of your home by **7:00 a.m.** on the day of pick-up.

**NOTE**: Crews <u>may arrive early</u> to your district if they are ahead of schedule. <u>They will return</u> on the scheduled day to collect any more leaves set out at that time.

**The Drop-Off Center** (located at 750 Sentry Drive) will accept leaves at no charge to the City of Waukesha residents from **October 19 through December 11**. Drop-Off Center hours:

Mondays 1 p.m. until 6 p.m., October 26 through November 23 (<u>Leaves only</u> on Mondays).

Wednesdays 11 a.m. until 7 p.m., through November 25 (Normal public hours).

Saturdays 8 a.m. until 4 p.m., year-round (Normal public hours).

## Raking of leaves into the gutter is prohibited by the City Ordinance 6.05 (5).

No person shall throw or place or deposit or cause to be deposited directly or indirectly any dirt, straw, ashes, leaves, rubbish, litter or other refuse matter in any street, alley, or public place in the City.

## Burning of leaves or other debris is also prohibited by the City Ordinance 21.04 (3) (d).

Materials for outdoor burning shall not include rubbish, garbage, recyclable articles, trash, yard waste, green wood, pressure-treated lumber, any material made or coated with rubber, plastic, leather or petroleum-based materials and shall not contain any flammable or combustible liquids.
